Dear Residential Property/Business Owner:

This is to inform you that the Borough of Lodi enforces its ordinance, dated March 9, 2009, which covers security alarms installed in your home and/or business. This Ordinance has some stipulations with regard to obtaining permits for your alarm system and the renewal of these permits on a yearly basis. The failure for someone who does not register or renew their permit with the Lodi Police Department will be subject to a fine of up to \$50.00 as stated in the Ordinance.

The permit, which is issued by the Lodi Police Department, is available at the Lodi Police Department headquarters or on the Lodi Police Department website, www.lodipd.org and will be issued by the Central Services Division of the Lodi Police Department. In order to obtain a permit or a permit renewal you must complete the form in its entirety and return to us. Currently, there is no charge for an Alarm Permit or the renewal of said permit.

Also, in accordance with this ordinance, the owner will be subject to fines for false alarms coming from their residence and/or business. The fine for the 1st offense for any violation of the ordinance will be assessed at \$50.00 for a false alarm. The fine will increase from there for a second infraction and any subsequent false alarms coming from said location.
